**RE: TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 3, 2014**

**Recommendation:**

Approve and adopt the resolution recommending the following:

1. Install two (2) attachable speed bumps in the Depot parking lot between Webb Street and Horseshoe Bar Road.
2. Trim trees, stencil "25 mph" and "SLOW", and add a red flasher at the three-way stop on Circle Drive.
3. Stripe a centerline, fog lines and stencil "25 mph" in both direction on Arcadia Avenue between King Road and Corwin Court.
4. Paint two (2) 10 minute parking stalls on Doc Barnes Drive adjacent to Devine Desserts business.
5. Add to the Capital Improvement Program the installation of bike lanes on Taylor Road from Alice's Fruit shed to the Feed Store.

**Issue Statement and Discussion**

On September 3, 2014, Staff met with the Sheriff's Department and Loomis Fire Department to discuss recent traffic concerns throughout Town. The following traffic concerns were gathered by field observations, accident history and/or public/Council requests.

## **2. Circle Drive**

- Staff received a complaint of speeding on Circle Drive by a resident. The location of concern is the segment west of the 3-way stop at Circle & S. Holly.

There are no accidents on this segment. With two 90 degree curves on each end of this road segment and a stop sign in between, the Committee believes the only way for vehicles to speed is to go through the stop.

The Committee recommends trimming several trees to make the stop sign more visible and add a red flasher at the top of the stop sign pole. Staff will also stencil "25 mph" and "SLOW" on the pavement. The Sheriff plans to meet with the resident regarding the concern.

## **3. Arcadia Avenue**

- Staff received a resident complaint of speeding on Arcadia Avenue between King Road and Corwin Court.

The Committee recommends striping the segment with a centerline strip, fog lines and stencil "25 mph" in both directions.

- **Parking:**

### **1. Tudor Way**

- Staff received a complaint of a truck and trailer parking along Tudor Way obstructing visibility in the area.

The truck and trailer belongs to the resident at the corner of Tudor & Shawn intersection. The resident has the right to park there, but it is in a unique area of the road alignment that causes traffic circulation concerns. The resident could park on Shawn Way which would eliminate the problem, but staff assumes there are valuable work items in the trailer and the resident doesn't want it out of site. The Sheriff plans to talk to the resident to get more information.

The Committee has no recommendation at this time. Staff will look further into the concern.

### **2. Doc Barnes Drive**

- Staff received a complaint from the business owner of Devine Desserts regarding no parking for her customers in the area.

During the approval process of Devine Desserts development, the applicant was required to construction parking stalls behind the Horseshoe Bar Retail center to accommodate parking. The applicant abided by the condition and constructed the stalls. Now that the business is in

**WHEREAS**, funding will come from various transportation accounts used for Capital Improvement Program projects and the Transportation Account under material and supplies, street sign repair and replacement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Town Council of the Town of Loomis approves the following Traffic Safety Committee recommendations:

1. Install two (2) attachable speed bumps in the Depot parking lot between Webb Street and Horseshoe Bar Road.










