



## TOWN COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS FOR SEPTEMBER

### Councilmember Robert Black:

**Placer County Air Pollution Control District** – The board held a hearing on the preliminary budget for 2015-2016, and recommended approval. We received an update on the search for a new Director, and it's going well. The Board approved an advanced budget authorization for Contracted support Services, and a technical services contract with USDA. The Board also approved the Placer County Ozone Emergency Episode Plan.

**School Liaison** – The schools have been out for the summer, and I haven't met with the Grammar School or High School superintendents.

**Business Liaison** – Due to conflicting schedules, I was not able to attend the meeting on the 5<sup>th</sup> of August with the Chamber of Commerce Economic Development Committee. The Town Manager went in my place.

### Councilmember Dave Wheeler

#### SACOG

- Since the SACOG Board met in June, Governor Brown signed the State Budget with allocations of \$2.7 billion in Cap and Trade funding. The Governor also called for a Special Session on Transportation and Infrastructure to address on-going funding challenges. SACOG's [state advocacy](#) activities include tracking the 20 related bills introduced since July that may see Governor action in 2015. The SACOG Board voted in June to support Senate Bill 16, with protections to ensure (Beall) dedicated funding for road rehabilitation and maintenance projects, and with a recommendation to extend the sunset proposed from 5 to 10 years.
- Members of the SACOG Board constitutes the region's Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) which is responsible for developing and maintaining the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plans (ALUCPs) for the counties of Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba. The ALUC is also charged with working with the local governments in each county to ensure consistency with land use decisions around each airport. In August, the ALUC determined that the [Proposed Yolo County Airport-related Zoning Changes](#) was consistent with the ALUCPs for the Yolo County Airport, Borges-Clarksburg Airport, and the Watts-Woodland Airport.
- The Board approved the Sacramento Region Transportation [Climate Adaptation Plan](#), including a vulnerability assessment, policy recommendations, and a series of implementation actions. The SACOG Board and staff extended its appreciation to the Civic Spark members who worked collaboratively to author the plan drawing on their technical expertise in environmental science.
- SACOG staff presented a preliminary [draft 2016 MTP/SCS](#) at all three policy committees in August. The Board is scheduled to take action at its September 17 meeting to release the Draft MTP/SCS for a 60-day public review and comment period. Following the comment period, public comments will be responded to and presented to the SACOG Board. Board action on the final plan is scheduled for February, 2016.
