

Mayor Dave Wheeler:

1. SACOG

- SACOG continues to apply for State and Federal grants that will aid in transportation planning.
- There was a presentation on "High Speed Rail Funds" and some of the benefits for regional rail service that will feed into system.
- 9 Community workshops to update the Metropolitan Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy will be completed in November and the draft findings will be presented in spring go 2015.

2. SPMUD/Loomis 2X2 Committee

- The committee met on October 29th.
- The sewer expansion project is continuing to move forward.
- SPMUD is placing a liner in the existing sewer line that will add some temporary increase in capacity.
- The draft engineering is almost complete and appears that the cost will be reduced from the original estimations.

1. Local Agency Formation Commission
