RE: Resolution Approving Personnel Benefits

ISSUE

The Council is asked to approve changes in costs of personnel benefits.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve resolution authorizing benefit changes.

MONEY

The cost of the benefit changes is estimated to add approximately \$5,000.00 dollars to current yearly payroll costs.

CEQA

There are no CEQA issues associated with changes in personnel wages and benefits.

DISCUSSION

The resolution provides for the following:

- Increase payment for health plan premiums in line with the State annuitant rate for the various CalPERS health plans for the 2014 calendar year

The Town has paid the State annuitant rate for health plan premiums since 2004. The rate has changed over the last few years as noted in the following table:
