

**Mayor Dave Wheeler:**

**1. SACOG**

- **Crude oil shipping:** Phillips 66 is proposing a refinery expansion in San Luis Obispo (this is in addition to the Benicia expansion), which may result in the additional transportation of crude oil by rail through the region. The SACOG Board approved the submission of a letter highlighting safety concerns, including advance noticing, storage of shipments in urbanized areas, training and preparation of emergency response crews, freight car selection, priority funding for rail safety projects, inspection equipment, and protocols for implementation of positive train controls.
- **Public Outreach for Transportation Planning:** An overview of the public outreach for regional transportation planning was presented by Dr. Hugh Clark of CJI Research. The full report is due in early spring 2015.

**2. SPMUD/Loomis 2X2 Committee.**

- The committee did not meet. However, there was a workshop held on November 13<sup>th</sup> with the stakeholders involved in the Loomis Diversion Line. The next step to receive input is from the major property owners as to the location of the line.
