RE: 2013/2014 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM – REVISION TO THE TAYLOR ROAD OVERLAY PROJECT

Recommendation:

Approve the revised project limits for the Taylor Road Overlay Project from Sierra College Boulevard to Oak Street.

Issue Statement and Discussion

Included in the 2013/2014 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is the Asphalt Overlay of Taylor Road from Sierra College Blvd. to Horseshoe Bar Road. Since the Town has recently acquired Bennett Engineering to provide the streetscape design for Taylor Road from Horseshoe Bar Road to Oak Street as part of the Town Center Master Plan, it would be best to stop the Overlay project at Oak Street. This will avoid any removal and/or modifications to newly paved roadway, and allow Bennett to design the frontage landscape & hardscape improvements without being restricted by the road elevation. The cost savings by eliminating the overlay between Horseshoe Bar Road and Oak Street will go toward the Taylor Road Reconstruction Project located between Sierra College Blvd. and the south Town limits.

CEQA Requirements

This project is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15301. (c&d) (Class 1), "Existing Facilities" of the guidelines.

Financial and/or Policy Implications

Funding will come from the Transportation Development Act Account, Gas Tax Account and the General Fund Reserve Transportation Account.
