**Recommendation:**

Approve and adopt the resolution to:

- Add additional signage and striping on Taylor Road between Sierra College Blvd and Circle Drive,
- Relocate the speed limit sign on Horseshoe Bar Road to the Town limit line, and
- Add three 20 minute parking spaces on Doc Barnes Drive adjacent to the Chamber Office.

**Issue Statement and Discussion**

On July 16, 2012, Staff met with the Sheriff's Department (Bob Brodovsky), Loomis Fire Department (Dave Wheeler) to discuss recent traffic concerns throughout Town. The following traffic concerns were gathered by field observations, accident history and/or residents requests.

• **Speeding:**

The following streets were brought to the Town's attention for Speeding:

**1. Taylor Road from Circle Drive to Sierra College Boulevard**

- Staff has observed and received complaints regarding vehicle speeds along this stretch of roadway. This segment has a speed limit of 40 mph which reduces dramatically to 25 mph at Circle Drive. Reduce speed signs have been installed, but more signage and striping may be needed. The Committee has discussed controlled measures such as stop signs or a signal at either Circle Drive or Shawn Way, but more research and field observation is needed. The Committee agrees that slowing down the speeds on this stretch is the goal, but does not want to produce a new congestion problem on Taylor during morning and afternoon traffic.

3. Add three 20 minute parking spaces on Doc Barnes Drive adjacent to the Chamber Office.


