

TO: TOWN COUNCIL  
FROM: TOWN MANAGER   
RE: BLUE ANCHOR PARK DEDICATION PLAQUE

**ISSUE**

It has been customary to prepare a plaque to memorialize a Town facility construction such as the Blue Anchor Park.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Approve whether or not to prepare a plaque and if so approve wording and determine whether there is a favored spot and/or method to display the plaque.

**CEQA**

There are no CEQA requirements involved in naming a park or having a dedication ceremony.

**MONEY**

The cost of the plaque would run under \$1,000 plus about \$500 if set it in a stone. Money would come from the Park Development Fund.

**DISCUSSION**

When the Town constructed the Loomis Station Transportation Facility (Depot parking lot), rehabbed the Depot Building, and rehabbed the SPMUD building for Town Hall use there were plaques produced to memorialize the particular facility. Following is wording for a Blue Anchor Park plaque that follows the examples of the previous bronze plaques using the same size and design.

One question is where to display such a plaque. Some plaques are on walls and some are in stone. If the Council has a preference please make it known. If not, then Staff will look to place the plaque in a stone and set the stone to the right or left of the stairway leading from the Depot area to the Blue Anchor park area.
