SUBJECT: KING ROAD OVERLAY PROJECT – ADVERTISE FOR BIDS 

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Plans and Specifications for the King Road Overlay Project with the findings that the project is exempt under CEQA categories 15301 and authorize Staff to advertise for bids.

ISSUE STATEMENT AND DISCUSSION:

The King Road Overlay Project is currently scheduled as part of the 2009-2010 Capital Improvement Program. As discussed during the budget hearings, projects that could be funded without General fund reserves would be able to continue through the process for construction. To make sure funding will be available for this project, staff has set-up the bid document in several bid segments as follows:

- Base Bid will be to overlay King Road from Sierra College Blvd. to Humphrey Road,
- Additional Bid item A1 will be to add pavement reinforcement fabric for segment Sierra College Blvd. to Humphrey Rd.,
- Additional Bid item A2 will be to overlay King Road from Humphrey Rd to Taylor Road,
- Additional Bid item A3 will be to add pavement reinforcement fabric for segment Humphrey Rd. to Taylor Rd.
- Additional Bid item A4 will be to overlay King Road from Taylor Rd to Boyington Rd., and
- Additional Bid item A5 will be to add pavement reinforcement fabric for segment Taylor Rd to Boyington Rd.

The Bid opening is scheduled for September 2, 2010. Once the bids have been received, staff will select the lowest base bid with any of the additional items that keep the cost below the estimated funding. The project will begin in October and be completed in 45 to 65 days depending on weather and additional items added.

CEQA:

This project is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15301. (c&d) (Class 1), "Existing Facilities" of the guidelines.

FINANCIAL AND/OR POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

This project is included in the 2009/2010 fiscal year Capital Improvement Program (CIP). Construction costs are estimated at \$400,000. Funding will be provided by the Town's Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds (\$180,000), Town's Traffic Congestion Relief Funds (\$100,026) and State Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds (\$119,974).

Notice is hereby given that the Town Council of the Town of Loomis, State of California, will receive sealed bids at the office of the Town Clerk of said Town, Town Hall, 6140 Horseshoe Bar Road, Loomis, California 95650, for:

KING ROAD OVERLAYPROJECT:

- **2 inch overlay**
- **Edge grinding & Driveway conforms**
- **Striping and markings**
- **Traffic Control**

Also, additional pavement segments and/or reinforcement fabric may be added should funding be available.

The Project shall be completed in Forty-five (45) days. Said bids to be received up to 3:00 p.m., September 2, 2010 (Thursday).

Federal guide lines are in-effect.

Each bidder must submit a proposal to the Town Clerk on standard forms which are contained in the project specifications. Said proposal to be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond of ten percent of the amount of the bid submitted, to be made payable to the Town of Loomis.

Contractor and subcontractors who may be awarded a contract will be required to maintain an affirmative action program, the standards of which are contained in the Standard Specifications. The Town Council of the Town of Loomis reserves the right to reject any or all bids received as the public good may require.

Plans and specifications, to which all prospective bidders are referred, are available in the office of the Town Engineer, Town Hall. A charge of **\$30.00** (sales tax included) will be made for a complete set of plans and specifications, which is nonrefundable. Checks should be made payable to the Town of Loomis.

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Section 1770, et. seq. of the California Labor Code, the Contractor shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the office of the Town Clerk, 6140 Horseshoe Bar Road, Loomis, California 95650, which copies shall be made available to any interested party on request.


The Contractor shall forfeit, as penalty to the Town, twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each day or portion thereof, for each workman paid less than the stipulated prevailing rates for any work done under the contract by him or by any subcontractor under him, in violation of the provisions of such Labor Code. The provisions of Section 1775 of said Labor Code shall be complied with.

Notice is also hereby given that all bidders may be required to furnish a sworn statement of their financial responsibility, technical ability and experience before award is made to any particular bidders. Before submitting bids, Contractor shall be licensed in accordance with the provisions of Section 7000 through 7145, inclusive, of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California. The successful Contractor will be required to furnish two acceptable surety bonds; one for faithful performance and the other for labor and materials. Each bond is to be executed in a sum equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. The successful Contractor will be required to obtain a business license from the City and pay related fees.

A Class "A" or C12 Contractor's License is required to complete this project. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of forty-five (45) days after the date set for the opening thereof.
