GREEN RIBBON TASK FORCE INFORMATION

ISSUE

For the 2010 year Mayor Liss plans to name and chair an informal group (Green Ribbon Task Force) that will advise him on sustainability issues.

RECOMMENDATION

Receive and file information.

CEQA

There are no CEQA issues because it is self evident that the Mayor working with an advisory body for his benefit will not impact the environment.

MONEY

There are no money issues with this item because it does not concern the Town.

DISCUSSION

For the 2010 year Mayor Liss plans to name and chair an informal group called the "Green Ribbon Task Force" in order to:

- identify current good examples of green and sustainable policies and programs
- consider green and sustainable policies and programs that the Town could adopt (e.g. Improve the Town's recycling program)
- identify businesses in Loomis that offer green and sustainable services or products
- identify business sectors in Loomis that could offer more green and sustainable services or products

The group may be composed of Loomis citizens and business interests augmented with advisors from the County, State, non-profit and private sectors. If Council Members have thoughts for the Mayor's consideration please let him know.
