RE: CONSENT ITEM
SECOND READING ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL CODE
HAVING TO DO WITH PURCHASING

ISSUE

At the July meeting Council agreed that consultant contracts should include a public education and participation component and Council held first reading of a draft ordinance in August.

RECOMMENDATION

Hold public hearing and first reading of ordinance as presented or as Council may edit.

CEQA

There are no CEQA issues in crafting purchasing rules and regulations.

MONEY

Money issues would likely arise in increased costs for certain consultant services because meeting costs can easily exceed \$300 per meeting. Add in postage and copying and the costs can run over \$1,000 per meeting depending on the extent of notification. A focused public education and outreach effort can run in excess of \$25,000 if extensive surveys (phone, mail etc) are done.

DISCUSSION

First reading of the ordinance was done at the August 2010 meeting. Council agreed to change Section 2 and add the word "outreach" in the new section F phrase so that a consultant will provide "public outreach and education and encourage public participation ..." That change has been made. In addition there was a chapter numbering error in the first reading that has been corrected. The previous ordinance referred to chapter 13.12.060 and that should have been chapter 3.12.060

Following is the edited and corrected Ordinance revising the Town purchase procedures.

ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LOOMIS
AMENDING SECTION 3.12.060 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD LANGUAGE
REQUIRING A PUBLIC EDUCATION AND PARTICIPATION COMPONENT IN
CONSULTANT CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town government to have informed citizens; and

WHEREAS, consultant contracts that the Town may enter into should include a public education and participation component;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Loomis Town Council does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 3.12.060 of the Loomis Municipal Code in the opening paragraph is hereby amended to read:

FROM: “Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, purchases of supplies and equipment, and the sale of personal property, shall be by written contract with the lowest responsible bidder, if a sale, pursuant to the procedure prescribed in this section.”

TO: “Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, purchases of consultant services, supplies and equipment, and the sale of personal property, shall be by written contract with the lowest responsible bidder, if a sale the highest bidder, pursuant to the procedure prescribed in this section.”

Section 2. Chapter 3.12.060 of the Loomis Municipal Code hereby amended to add:

Section F. Consultant Contracts Special Provision. Consultant contracts that will include public meetings shall include a clause in the notice inviting bids, and in the final contract, detailing how the consultant will provide public outreach and education and encourage public participation in the work that will be done for the Town, and identify the cost thereof.

Section 3. The Town Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published as required by law in the Loomis News, a newspaper of general circulation, and posted at three (3) locations within fifteen (15) days of the certification to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Town.
